He was one of the Confederation Poets and was elected a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada in 1895. He is widely regarded as Canada s finest 19th century English language poet. Lampman s poetry concerns Canada s rural life and the wonders of nature and can be compared to British romantic and nature poetry contemporary to his life. Lampman s ability to write detailed, meaningful, poems that depicted traditional Canadian and Native American life was one of his greatest triumphs as a poet and probably one of the reasons why his work has had lasting import in the Canadian canon.
